**NOTE: We are offering 4 trials (2 per day). The first entry in EACH trial is \$25.00, if you enter same dog in 2 rally trials, you must pay \$25 for 1<sup>st</sup> entry fee PER trial. The \$15.00 “additional entry” applies only when you are entering BOTH Advanced and Excellent OR Advanced, Excellent & Masters \*\*in the same trial.\*\***

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**Please let us know by September 1st if you anticipate completing an RAE or RACH at this trial, so we can have a ribbon ordered & ready for you. NO extra ribbons will be ordered for this trial!!!**

## Class Prizes

A qualifying score is required for all prizes offered in all regular classes.

Rally ribbon and prize awards:

1st Place – Blue Ribbon

A dark green qualifying ribbon will be awarded to each dog receiving a qualifying score in regular classes. Each dog will receive a toy for entering – one toy per dog for the weekend.

### **NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS \*\*\*PLEASE READ\*\*\***

Send completed entry forms (include both front AND back of the official AKC entry form) with correct fees to: Christina Wakefield, 8406 Blue Lick Rd., Louisville, KY 40219. Entry forms MUST be signed at bottom by owner or owner's duly authorized agent. Entries unsigned or mailed in without both front and back of the official AKC entry form will NOT be accepted. Postdated checks will NOT be accepted. Please fill out the entry legibly! Make checks or money orders payable to: Agility Cues For You or AQ4U.

Receipt of entry confirmations will only be emailed. After closing, confirmation letters with armband numbers and judging program will be emailed.

We cannot guarantee on-time arrival of entries sent via Fed Ex or other overnight service. **BE SURE TO CHECK THE SIGNATURE WAIVER BOX ON YOUR MAILING FORM!!** Due to her work schedule, trial secretary can NOT travel to a Fed Ex, UPS or USPS location to pick up entries that require a signature. **VERY IMPORTANT - CHECK THE SIGNATURE WAIVER BOX ON YOUR MAILING FORM!**

The term “dog” means either dog or bitch.

Any exhibitor whose bitch has come in season or any dog which has incurred an injury or passed away after the closing date, may obtain a refund of their entry fee (less \$5.00 for AKC fees and administrative expenses per entry) upon presentation of a Veterinarian's certificate to the Show Secretary prior to the start of the trial. NOTE: There will NOT be any refunds of entries AFTER closing date except for above reason. No refunds on overpayments of \$6.00 or less.

The handler is solely responsible for having the dog at ringside when scheduled. Judges are not required to wait for any dog holding up a class. Dogs need to be at the trial only at scheduled time of judging and may leave immediately after, unless required for further judging.

If, because of riots, civil disturbances, weather, or other acts beyond the control of CKHGC and/or AQ4U, it is impossible to open or to complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made.

CKHGC and/or AQ4U will not be responsible for loss or damage of property while on show site.

No entry will be accepted which carries any conditions regarding its acceptance.

CKHGC and/or AQ4U will not be responsible for errors made on entries. Please double check entry prior to sending. Owners are responsible for errors. No entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

Entries received without fees will not be accepted. Unsigned checks and returned checks do not constitute payment of fees.

Recording fees will be required for each dog entered at any licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial, Rally Trial or Tracking Test. This fee is to be collected by the show giving club and paid to the American Kennel Club.

There will be an AKC Recording Fee of \$3.50 per 1<sup>st</sup> entry in the Rally Trial, plus \$3.00 per additional entries. If a dog is entered in more than one class the fee is collected on all classes the dog is entered in, excluding non-regular classes. AQ4U pays the recording fee. Competitors need NOT include the recording fees in their entry fee check. This is just as an FYI!

All dogs must be kept on a leash or crated at all items, except as allowed in the Show Ring. **NO FLEXI LEADS ALLOWED INSIDE SHOW SITE.**

The ring surface is Astroturf at AQ4U's training facility.

The Show Site will open 1 hour prior to the start of the event, and will close 1 hour after the event. Ample crating will be available. Crating will only be allowed in areas marked. Water and indoor restrooms are available at the Show Site. Please keep aisles clear. **TARPS MUST BE UNDER ALL CRATES AND CHAIRS!**

We will be breaking for lunch each day. There are several fast-food restaurants near the Show Site. We will also be offering lunch each day for \$6. Pre-order only. See order form in this premium.

Transfers will be allowed for these trials. All transfers will run at the end of their class jump height. Transfers must be received at least 30 minutes prior to the start of each trial.

## INSTRUCTIONS

1. (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).

2. (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e. A or B division.

3. A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time entries for an event closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his/her name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to the AKC. (For complete rules, refer to Chapter 11, Section 3.)

4. Dogs listed in the **AKC Canine PartnersSM Program** may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC Rally trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC Number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box. Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entries.

I certify that I am the actual owner of this dog, or that I am the duly authorized agent of the actual owner whose name I have entered above. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry and of the holding of this event and of the opportunity to have the dog judged and to win prize money, ribbons, or trophies, I (we) agree to hold the AKC, the event giving club, their members, directors, governors, officers, agents superintendents or event secretary and the owner and/or lessor of the premises and any provider of services that are necessary to hold this event and any employees or volunteers of the aforementioned parties, and any AKC approved judge, judging at this event, harmless from any claim for loss or injury which may be alleged to have been caused directly or indirectly to any person or thing by the act of this dog while in or about the event premises or grounds or near any entrance thereto, and I (we) personally assume all responsibility and liability for any such claim; and I (we) further agree to hold the aforementioned parties harmless from any claim for loss, injury or damage to this dog.
