Notice to Exhibitors

- Entries will open at 8:00 A.M. on Wednesday, March 6, 2019 EST at the Trial Secretary's home. Entries received before that time will be returned. **NO hand-carried entries will be accepted.**
- Make checks or money orders payable to the Central Kentucky Herding Group Club (CKHGC). All fees are payable in U.S. funds. Please type or print all information required on entry form. Entry fees are **\$50.00** per trial per dog per class on Saturday and Sunday for duck runs.
- Exhibition only entries will be accepted, with the same entry fee and closing time and date as regular entries.
- Entries close at 5:00 P.M. EDT, Wednesday, April 17, 2019 at the Trial Secretary's home, after which time entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as provided in Chapter 1, Section 13 of the *AKC Herding Regulations*. When numerical limits are exceeded, additional entries will be placed on an alternates list.
- Drawing for running order will be held at the Trial Secretary's home on Wednesday, April 17, 2019 at 10:30 P.M. EDT..
- There shall be no refund of entry fees for dogs that are absent, retired, removed, excused or disqualified or if because of riots, civil disturbances, or other acts beyond the control of the Club it is impossible to open or compete in the Trial. If a dog is absent and is replaced by an alternate, then the entry fee shall be refunded.
- Entrants on the alternates' list must check in with the Trial Secretary on the Trial grounds no later than thirty (30) minutes prior to start of trial each day. Alternates that do not have the opportunity to run shall have the entry fee refunded.
- Requests to move-up must be given to the Trial Secretary at least thirty (30) minutes prior to the start of the trial.
- Bitches in season will be permitted to run in catalog order in Trial classes. Bitches in season entered in Test classes will be run at the end of the Test classes.
- Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. A \$35.00 collection fee will be added to each returned check.
- No refunds will be made for duplicated entries or errors on entry blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such.
- The Central Kentucky Herding Group Club may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause and no one shall have any claim against the Central Kentucky Herding Group Club or any official thereof.
- The Trial site is in the Eastern Time zone.
- There will be a lunch break at the judge's discretion each day.
- Many restaurants are available in Harrodsburg. Lunch will be available for purchase on site **Saturday only**.
- Please clean up after your dog and yourself. We ask the cooperation of exhibitors in helping to keep the Trial location as clean as possible in order to be able to hold future AKC events at this facility.
- The initial handlers' duck meeting will be held at 7:45 A.M. each day. Subsequent handlers' meetings will be held before each class.
- A separate entry must be made for each dog. The AKC waiver statement included in the entry blank, must accompany each entry and must be SIGNED for the entry to be accepted. Entries without legible phone/e-mail info will be refused.
- All dogs must be held on leash or otherwise restricted except when competing. Under no circumstances will dogs be allowed to disturb the resting stock or interfere outside the arena with another dog's performance in the arena. **See Chapter 1, Section 20 of the AKC Herding Regulations.**
- **This is a working farm, please take care to close and latch all gates**
- Please remember to bring shade, water, chairs & raingear
- Overnight camping is available on site
- The Central Kentucky Herding Group Club, its officers and representatives, the Trial Chair, Secretary, Committee and the owner of the Trial site assume no responsibility for loss, damage or injury sustained by spectators, exhibitors' property and their dogs and further assume no responsibility for injury to children.

DIRECTIONS

Foxcroft Farm – 1285 Hopewell Road, Harrodsburg, KY 40330

From the North (*recommend this over following your GPS into Lexington and then across*):

I-75 South to exit 118 onto I-64 west. Take I-64 to exit 53A onto 127 South toward Lawrenceburg.

***You will go straight on this road until you turn at our corner. As a point of reference, from the Bluegrass Parkway, you will go south on Highway 127 for approx. 8.7 miles to Route 1160 on the right (your GPS will call it Talmadge Mayo Road, but the road sign reads 1160).

** Go 3 miles to Hopewell Road on your left. It only goes to your left & is a small road. The sign for the road is a small 4x4 post with the name written down the post. It is a little hard to see the sign and turn. Look for a Herding Trial sign. If you go as far as the Baptist Church, you have gone about ½ mile too far.

Go approx. ½ mile on Hopewell Road. You will go down a hill, up a hill & as you approach the curve in the road, our tan brick house is directly ahead of you. Go around the curve & immediately turn left into our driveway. We have a black 4-board wood fence.

Your GPS will tell you that you are at our house about 2/10 mile before you are there.

From the West

Go east on I-64 toward Lexington. Get off I-64 at exit #48 toward Lawrenceburg. At the end of the exit ramp, turn right onto 151. Take 151 until you come to a large

intersection which is 127. Turn right onto 127, southbound. Then follow the above directions, starting at ***.

From the East (on the Bluegrass Parkway)

Take the Bluegrass Parkway to exit 59A, Route 127 South, which is the Harrodsburg exit. That exit will put you onto 127 South. Then follow directions above starting at ***

From the South (on I-75) Take I-75 north to exit #59 onto 150 west. Follow 150 to Danville (stay on main road, do not take the right turn into town). 150 will turn into a bypass around Danville and becomes 127. You will not even notice when 150 becomes 127. Stay on 127 north to Harrodsburg. At the south end of Harrodsburg is another bypass and 127 will turn right and take you around town. There will be a traffic light at the start of the bypass and 2 traffic lights as you go around the bypass. At the 3rd traffic light on the bypass you will meet up with 127 and you turn right onto 127 to continue north. (I do NOT suggest you follow your GPS and stay straight at the end of the bypass, you will be on much smaller, winding roads.) Go about 6 miles north on 127 to 1160. Just before 1160 you will see a store called Kountry Kupboard on your left. 1160 only goes to your left and there is no traffic light. Turn left on 1160. (Your GPS will call it Talmadge Mayo Road but the road sign reads 1160).
